Safe Witness Plan

On the side of each black and white patrol car is the department motto of "Partners with the Community". Together we make a strong team against criminals. Be observant and work with your police department to stop crime. You can be anonymous in your communication with the police.

General

1. Keep a log and write things down. Even if you never report anything. Do not depend on your memory.
2. Look twice. Sometimes our mind plays tricks on us when we are nervous or excited.
3. Be safe. Don't be a hero. A good safe witness is what we want.
4. Be methodical. Start on the top and work your way down.
5. Don't be intimidated about being a snitch or rat-fink. Criminals do not deserve your respect or loyalty.

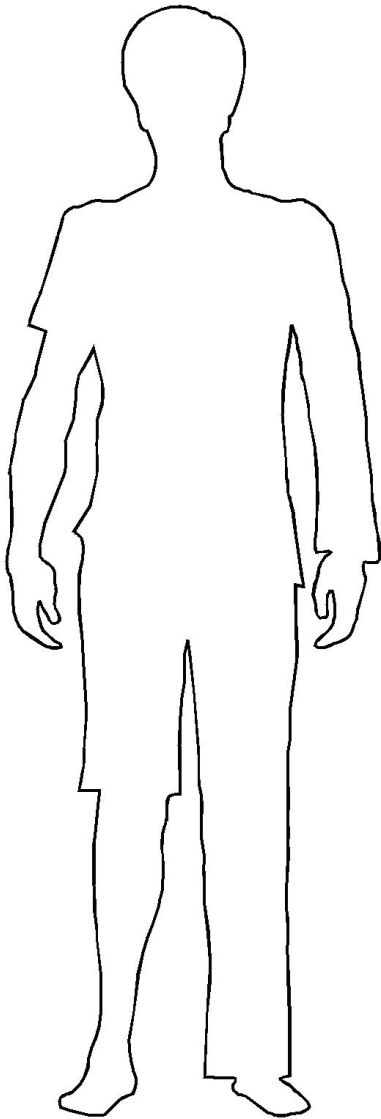

1. Do Not try to be a hero. Cooperate and don't risk yourself for property.
2. Do Not call attention to yourself.
3. Do Not provoke the robber.
4. Do Not resist or refuse the demands.
5. Do Not make any sudden moves.
6. Do Not try to overpower the criminal.
7. Do Not attempt to use any weapon. Weapons escalate the danger/risk.
8. Do Not try to follow the suspect(s) after they flee. Be a good witness!
9. Do Not do anything that would compromise the robbery process or slow the robber down from leaving the scene.
