## I.D.F CODES CONTINUED

The letter "G" for Gang Involvement, "D" Domestic Violence, "H" for highway enforcement, "S" for School Violence or "X" for Department Exercise (when mock calls are created) must be added to the IDF Code when clearing form a call. There are only four character fields available when entering this information into the MCT, so the Codes that already have a letter after the IDF Code, drop the letter and use "G", "D", "S", OR "X" (i.e. 413A will be 413G when clearing).
